(A)Experiential Learning

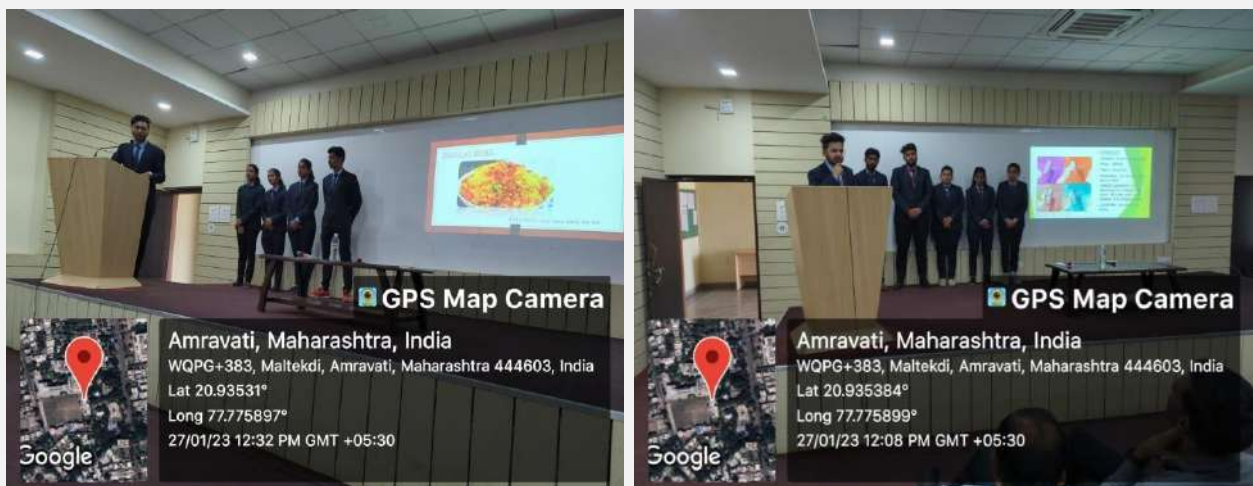
In Experiential learning students learn to take initiative, make decisions, and be accountable for the results. Students engage intellectually, creatively, emotionally, socially, or physically.

Udhyam-Explore Your Business Fundamentals

The whole activity involves initial investment by the Institute for giving it to the groups. It is mandatory for every group to give an ROI (Return on Investment) of 20% of the amount invested. The students from MBA 1st & 2nd year are divided in equal groups of 6 each. The groups are displayed on the notice board. The entire event is of 3 days. Day one every group has to give ppt presentation on his strategy and product selection target audience and tentative ROI. The group presentations are judged by an external person from the corporate world. Usually we prefer inviting alumni of our department. Day two students early morning report to department and every group is given the amount around Rs.2000. Within the prescribed time limit of 5 hours the student needs to work on field as planned. At the end of the time period every group has to submit the initial amount invested and the ROI to the co-coordinator. Day three the groups again have to give a PPT presentations.

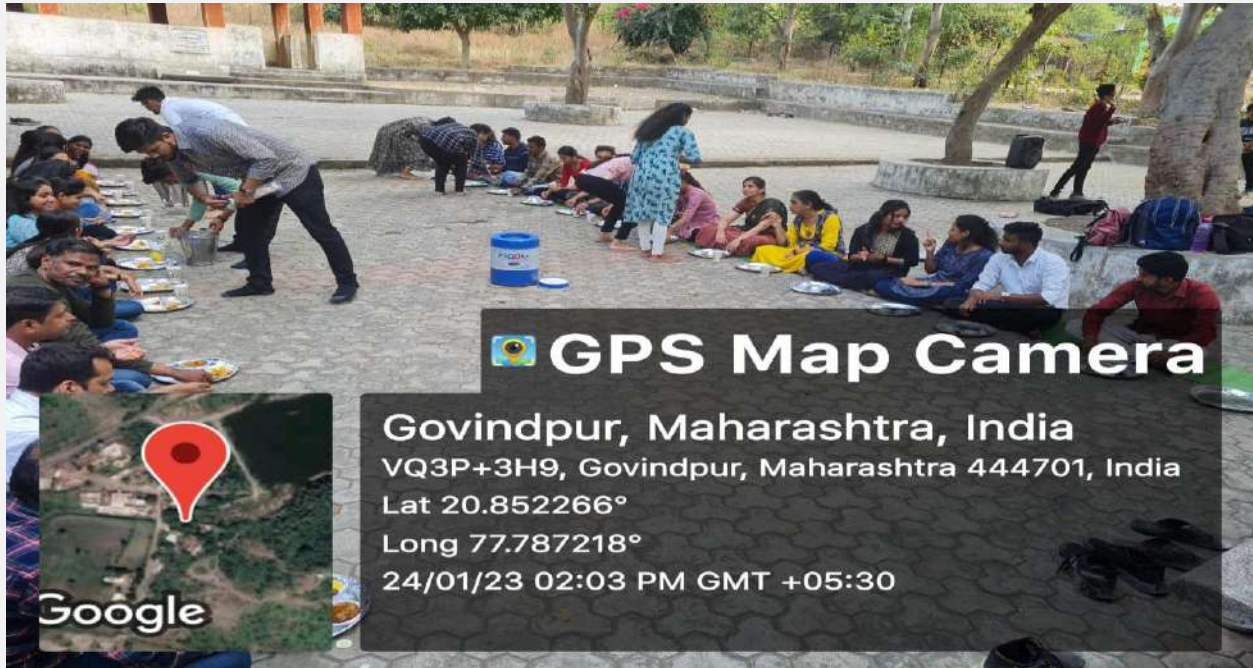

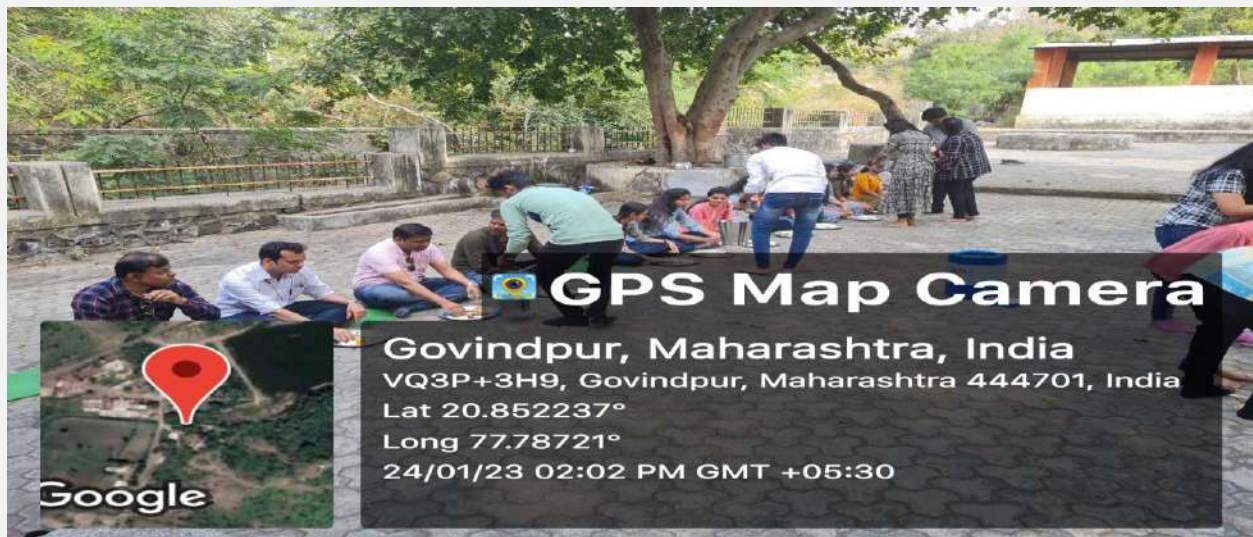

One day Workshop on “Preparation of NET/SET Examination”

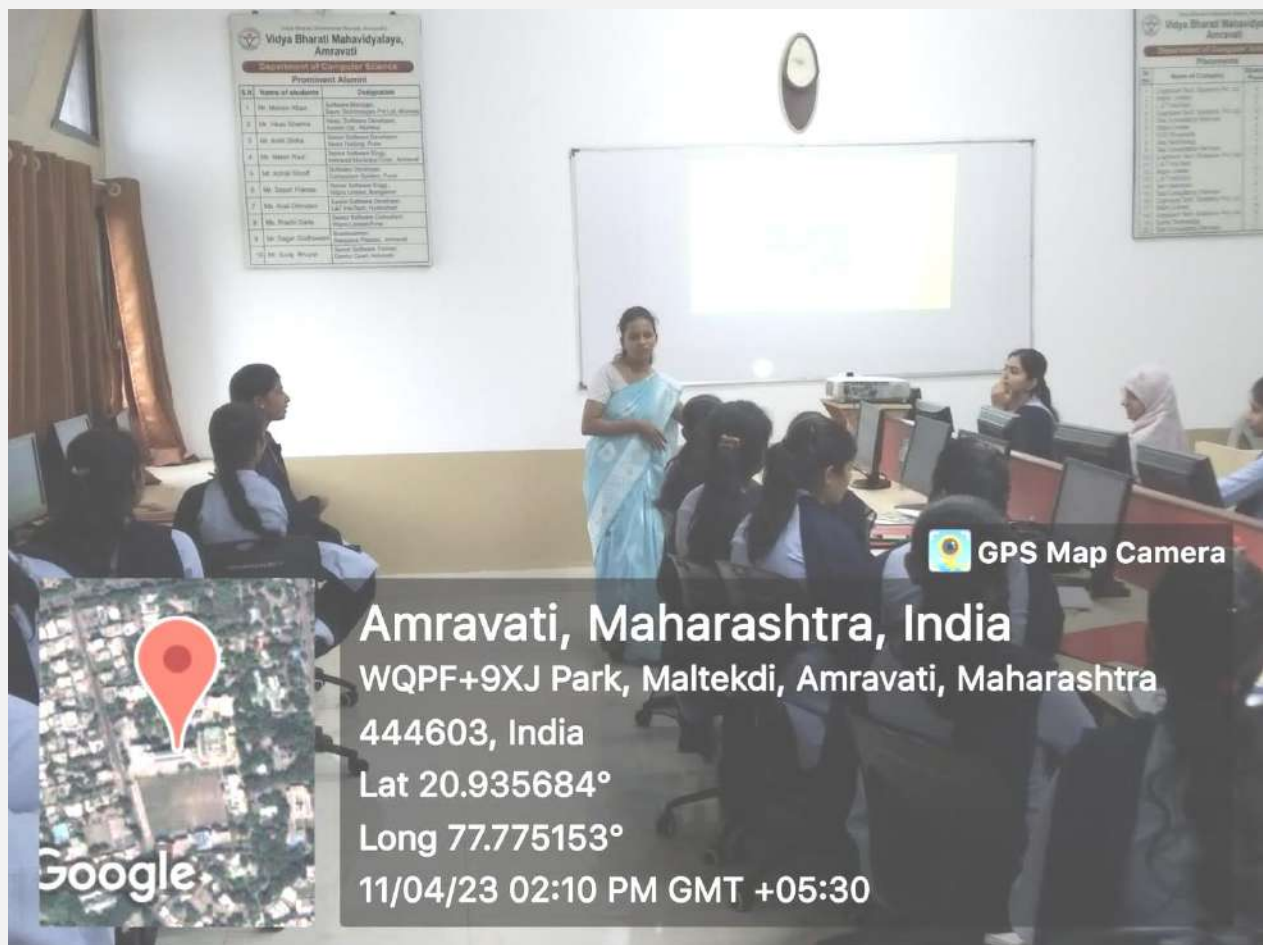
