Students who appeared and passed the university final year examination in the year 2023-24

The college follows the standard procedure prescribed by the affiliating university to conduct the various examinations. As per the procedure verbalized by the affiliating university, the students enroll for various programs and appear for the examination at the end of each semester.

For the academic year 2023-24, a total of 1189 students participated in the final year final semester examination. Remarkably, 873 students emerged successful in passing the university examination, achieving a pass percentage of 73.42. The final year student body comprised both Postgraduate (PG) and Undergraduate (UG) students. Among them, 772 UG students took the exam, with 559 successfully passing, while 417 PG students participated, and 314 passed the examination.

The affiliating university adhered to the traditional offline mode for conducting all examinations. The reaffirmation of the traditional examination method by the university was evident in the process, and students undertook these examinations at various designated centers across the city. This approach aimed to ensure a transparent and secure execution of the university examination.

While the examination process unfolded smoothly, there were a few grievances raised by students, which were promptly communicated to the Grievances and Redressal Cell. It is noteworthy that the cell efficiently addressed and resolved almost all grievances within the stipulated time, reflecting our commitment to ensuring a fair and just examination system.

The tabulated data below provides a comprehensive summary of the aforementioned statistics. The students of our college exhibited commendable performance, establishing a robust and recognizable presence in the university examination for the summer of 2024.
