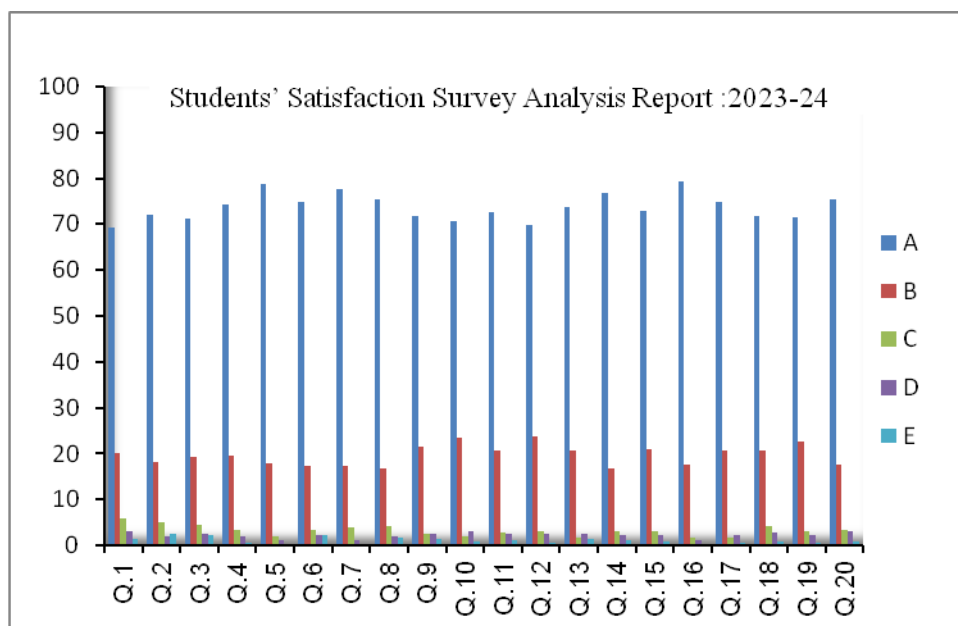

The following are the observations on Students' Satisfaction Survey feedback;

Key findings from the survey

1. A high percentage of students (93.67%) complete satisfaction over the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications
2. Students have expressed overall satisfaction regarding the fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. (96.45%)
3. Students have appreciated the teacher's encouragement for participation in extracurricular activities.


4. The college provides ample opportunities for cultural activities, sports activities and extracurricular activities. The students have opined that college also provides good environment for emotional growth of students.
5. The students have expressed satisfaction regarding the mentorship programme, skill development programme run by the college.

The SSS has also pointed out few grey areas where the college/ teachers/ departments do have scope for enhancement in quality of education. They are as follows:

1. Teachers should be updated as per New Education Policy (NEP) in their subjects.
2. Research Projects for Arts & Commerce Faculties.
3. Encouragement for research work.
4. Organization of more field visits for Arts & Commerce Faculties.
5. Registration for Online Certificate Courses.
6. Programmes on MPSC, UPSC, GRE, TOFEL, IIT JAM, etc entrance examination guidance.

The IQAC and College Authority give utmost importance to the findings of this survey because this way student come to believe that even they have a say in policy making. This was even we try to be true to the motto of our college, “we for Students”. This approach of participative policy making is satisfying for students. It is always impossible to please everyone but often we try to strive towards keeping most of them happy, most of the time.
