

7.2.1 Best Practice 2:

Animal Right Club: Conservation of Aquatic Animal Habitat

The Animal right Club organized a one-day study tour for M.Sc. Zoology students to the Fish Development Center at Mahan. This visit aimed to explore modern fish farming methods and emphasize the importance of animal rights in aquaculture. The tour offered exposure to sustainable fish farming techniques while encouraging discussions on ethical treatment and welfare of fish. The Fish Development Center specializes in breeding species like Rohu, Catla, and Mrigal. Advanced aquaculture techniques are used to enhance productivity while ensuring the welfare of aquatic organisms. The facility demonstrates sustainable practices that support local communities and protect aquatic ecosystems. On 14th October 2023, Dr. H. A. Patharikar and Dr. A. M. Vikhar served as the Activity In-charges for the event, which included a total of 43 participants: 40 students, 2 teaching staff members, and 1 non-teaching staff member.

Objectives of the Visit

1. To understand the significance of fish farming in providing nutritional and economic security.
2. To create awareness about ethical and sustainable fish rearing practices.
3. To promote the integration of animal rights principles in aquaculture.
4. To inspire students to adopt human practices in their future endeavors.

Key Learnings from the Visit

1. Modern Fish Farming Practices Students observed various stages of fish rearing, including spawning, fry care, and pond management. Techniques such as selective breeding and controlled feeding were demonstrated, highlighting their role in maximizing yield without compromising fish health.

2. Ethical Aquaculture The visit underscored the importance of ethical practices in fish farming, including:
o Maintaining proper stocking density to reduce stress.
o Monitoring water quality to ensure a healthy environment.
o Using humane methods during fish handling and harvesting.

3. Sustainability in Aquaculture The center employs eco-friendly technologies like biofilters and integrated farming systems. These methods minimize environmental impact and promote sustainable fish production.

4. Community Engagement The facility empowers local farmers with training and resources, encouraging them to adopt fish farming as a livelihood. This creates opportunities for economic growth and rural development.

Animal Rights and Aquaculture

The visit included discussions on how fish farming aligns with animal rights principles. Topics covered included:

- **Welfare in Captivity:** Ensuring that fish are reared in conditions that meet their physiological and behavioral needs.
- **Minimizing Stress:** Techniques to handle fish gently during breeding, feeding, and harvesting.
- **Balancing Productivity and Ethics:** The importance of adopting practices that prioritize animal welfare while maintaining economic viability.

Students were encouraged to reflect on the ethical dimensions of aquaculture and its implications for biodiversity and conservation.

1. Enhanced Knowledge: Students gained insights into the scientific, ethical, and practical aspects of fish farming, emphasizing its role in sustainable development.


