

Chikhaldara - A Dream Hill Station to visit

Chikhaldara is the nearest hill station to Amaravati. It is at 100 km from Amaravati and 1,088 m (3,570 ft) in height from sea level. It is blessed by the beauty of nature and has a wide range of history. It is the only coffee growing area of Maharashtra. The atmosphere is very exciting and enjoyable.

How did we go there:

We had gone to Chikhaldara by travels at 8:30 am in morning and came return at 10:30 pm.

Best time to visit Chikhaldara:

Best time to visit Chikhaldara is the month of January, February, March, October, November and December but we visited in the month of 23 August 2015.

Special Features:

Historical Background:

It is the place where Lord Krishna carried away Rukminee. Chikhaldara is named after who is the member of the court of king virat. Kichak was killed by Bheema, one of the Pandava brothers in the Mahabharata. He is said to have been killed by Bheema and thrown in the deep valleys called dari in Marathi language hence the name Kichakdara which was later on spelled as Chikhaldara. Some archaeologist think that Chikhaldara may be a part of Matsyadesh (kingdom of king Virat) in ancient times.

Chikaldara was discovered by Captain Robinson of the Hyderabad Regiment in 1823. The Englishmen found itparticularly attractive because the lush green hue of the place reminded them of England. When the leaves fell in September /October, they were reminded of autumn in England. There was even a proposal to make it the seat of the Government of India.

* Beautiful nature:

Nature of Chikhaldara is very beautiful due to which tourist are attracted towards this place. Mostly in summer, people visited this place to enjoy the cool atmosphere of Chikhaldara. Maharashtra government had provide all the services to the tourist such as food, shelter.

Bhimkund (Kitchakdari):



Bhimkund-Kichakdara holds mythological significance that attracts tourists, especially Hindu pilgrims year-round. This is the place, where Bhima killed Kichaka and threw his body into the valley, named Kichakdara. Bhimkund is the place, where Bhima wash his blooded hands after killing Kichaka.

It is about 3,500 ft deep and is well-known for the nearby waterfalls and cascades. Atmosphere is very cool at this place and water is very pure. Also here one species of red monkeys is also found.

Devi Point



Devi Point, located in the Amravati District, is situated close to the Shakkar Lake. There are few steps leading to this point on the hill top, from where tourists can view the originating point of the Chandrabhaga River. Travellers can also see the ruins of the Amravati Fort from the top of the Devi Point.

This point is located approximately 2 km from the local bus stand and has a temple of local goddess. The unique thing about this temple is that the water flows continuously inside the shrine, from a stone.

Panchbol Point (Five echo point):




Panchbol Point is a famous tourist spot in Chikhaldara that lies close to the Bir Lake. The main speciality of this point is that when someone shouts here, the sound is reflected back and heard five times. First four times voice can be heard clearly but at fifth time it is uncleared. Hence, this place is named as the Five Echo Point or Panchbol Point. This area is mainly a deep valley formed by four mountains, along with waterfalls.

&Gawilagad-Fort:



Gawaligad Fort is situated in the Amravati District, close to Chikhaldara. This fort is around 300 years old and was once controlled by Hindu and Mughal rulers. There are two lakes present within the fort, namely Khambtaloa and Bamnitaloa. A Gawali King, who was a descendent of Yadavas of Devagiri, built this fort during the 12th century. The three gates of this fort are known as the Delhi Darwaza, Kichakdara Darwaza and Fatheh Darwaza.



The 10 cannons in this fort are made from copper, brass and iron.



There are many carved sculptures in this fort that were constructed during the period of Nizams.

Vegitation:

As it has very cool atmosphere, many algae, bryophytes, pteridophytes, stoneworts, climbers, gymnosperms and angiosperms grows here. All heighted gymnosprms and angiospems are covered by a thick algal layers or climbers. As there are many lakes aquatic plants are also found here such as we found a pteridophyt plant Marselia in a small pond. This place is home to several endangered plant and animal specieses and hence a good place for research scholars to reseearch. This is the only place that contains vegitation of coffee in overall Maharashtra. As it as larg biodiversity in the form of forest ecosystems it has a lion's share in the conservation of flora and fauna of India. Some major plants we found there are as follows:

- Parasitic algaes (Algae grow on plants).
- 2. Lichens grows on stones.
- 3. Coffee plant
- 4. Azadirachta indica (Neem)
- Adhtoda vasaka (Adulsa).
- 6. Marselia
- 7. Aloe vera (Korphad).
- 8. Hiptis survelians (Rantulusi).
- 9. Achyranthus aspera (Aaghada).
- 10. Alternanthera sesilis (Chubuk kata).
- 11. Phyllanthus emblica (Amla).
- 12. Zinnia sps.

We found Chikhaldara most wonderful and beautiful place to visit. Each person in the world must visit Chikhaldara at least once during the lifetime. It has a good weather and enjoyable atmosphere.
