## **Workshop on Soft skills and Personality Development**

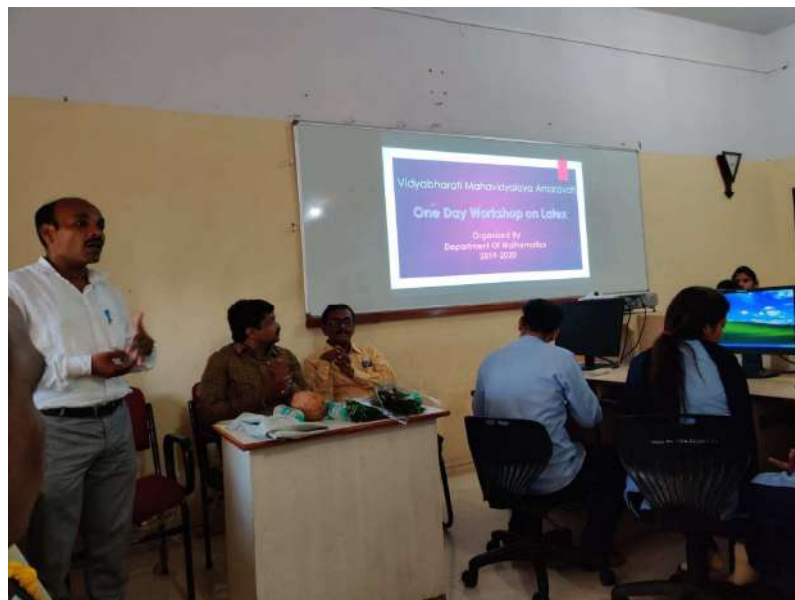
