INTRODUCTION

National Service Scheme Unit of Vidya Bharati Mahavidyalaya, Amravati organized a special winter camp in the adopted village, KarlaTq. Chandur Rly. District-Amravati from 04-02-2017 to 11-02-2017. This special camp was organised with the help of Panchayat Samiti of Chandur Rly. The main project of this camp was to make the village Green and Clean. The Volunteers of the NSS unit performed many other activities such as awareness programmes on Female Foeticide by performing dramas, tree plantation, health and hygiene, etc.

Day1: 04/02/2016 (Saturday)

- N.S.S. Camp Volunteers arrive at 4:00 p.m.at Camp place
- Cleaning of the camp area
- Enrolment of N.S.S. Volunteers for seven Days Camp
- Interaction between NSS Programme officer and people of village, Karala about the conduction of various activities and project during stay.
- Constitution of various committees for smoothening of work

Day 2: 05/02/2016 (Sunday)

In the dawn of the second Day, N.S.S. volunteers started their campaign by prayer at early morning on 06:00 a.m. After taking a breakfast the camp volunteers organised a Shramadan Programme. About 45 volunteers divided themselves into sub groups and went into the streets, lanes of the village and organized a cleanliness drive. Volunteers rallied into the streets of the village to create awareness among the villagers about the ensuing special camp programme in their village for a period of one week. This was followed by an

Inauguration Program held at High School of Village. The programme was started with lightening the lamp and NSS song. Hon'ble Dr. Rajesh Jayapurkar Director B.C.U.D.S.G.B.A.U.Amravati as a Chief Guest, Principal Dr. F. C. Raghuwanshi, Dr. Ganesh Malte Co-ordinator N.S.S. S.G.B.A.U. Amravati.Dr.Shrikant Patil Director Extension Dept. S.G.B.A.U. Amravati and Mrs. PuspaVaidyaSarpanch on the dais. The inaugural speech was delivered by Dr. Rajesh Jayapurkar emphasized the role of NSS in the community service. Program was conducted by NSS Volunteers and they were guided by N.S.S Programme officer Dr. D.S.Ramteke , Dr.NR. Thorat Asstt. Programme Officer and Ms. Kishori Rajgure, Lady Programme Officer. Sarpanch of the Village and several village people attended the function. Village authorities welcomed the team of Volunteers into their village and assured them all sorts of co-operation needed in making the special camp a success. Evening session begins with the Cultural programme, N.S.S. Volunteers participated in the cultural programme. After taking dinner volunteers formed the various committees for smoothening of work, discussed the regular schedule during the camp, discussed the plan of work regarding the project and the other activities to be conducted during the stay with NSS programme officer.

Day 3: 06/02/2016 (Monday)

The third was full of events. On the early morning of third day of camp volunteers assembled for the Prayer and yoga exercises. Self-defense training programme was also run from 28/12/18 to onwards. After breakfast, volunteers started their campaign by cleaning the surrounding area. About 45 volunteers divided themselves into sub groups and organized a cleanliness drive. Volunteers cleaned the village roads, removed dust heaps and attempted to create awareness on Cleanliness and hygiene. They swept with brooms on the roads of the village. Volunteers created awareness through door to door

campaign on cleanliness, importance of environment, water harvesting spread of diseases, and importance of ground water. On the same day, NSS Programme officers and student volunteers started their project work by finding an area after the discussion with village Sarpanch where the tree plantation is needed.

In the noon session, Mr. Nanadkishor Gandhi Brand Ambassador of Cleanliness campaign delivered a talk on Environment, Cleanliness and eradication of plastic to create awareness amongst the students as well as villagers. The other faculty Members joined in the programme. The evening session was devoted to Cultural programme- Hasya-KaviSammelan where Prof. G.S.Khobragade, C.M.Kadhi Mahavidyalaya, Achalpur, Prof. Gautam Guddhe Zee TV Frame recited their comedy poems and make the people to laugh.

Day4: 07/02/2016 (Tuesday)

After the regular Prarthana and Yoga exercises, the fourth day was begun with the project work with zeal and enthusiasm. It was mainly dedicated to Tree Plantation Programme. NSS Officers made the plants available from Bamboo Garden Nursery and the students started their work with the spirit to make the village Clean and Green. All the volunteers formed several groups of 4-5 and were advised to plant two saplings in the gardens, courtyards and safe places of every house in the village. In the following Session, Mr. Sunilji Deshpande delivered a talk as well as gave hands on training on handcrafts made by bamboo. In the evening session, a meeting was organized by the Programme Officer to discuss about outcomes of the day and planning for the next day after evening prayer.

Day 5: 08/02/2016 (Wednesday)

The Fifth day morning session was continued with Shramdan and Project work. In intellectual session Mr. Omsing Shekhawat KVK, Badnera guided

students as well as village peoples about testing of soil and water and the need of testing for the welfare of productivity of crops. After intellectual session a meeting was organized by the Programme Officer to discuss progress of project work and planning for the next day after evening prayer. Cultural events also organized during evening session N.S.S. Volunteers' presented a different activities such as group songs, solo performances, classical and folk dances. On this occasion Dr. B.D.Bundele, Dr.S.R. Akarte shared their experiences to the N.S.S. Volunteers.

Day 6: 09/02/2016 (Thursday)

After the regular Prarthana and Karate training, on the sixth day NSS volunteers conducted a rally against Female foeticide as it has become a disgraceful and shocking truth of our nation and to make the people of village aware about importance of girl child. In the noon session, Mrs. Jyotsna Mehekare Social worker delivered a talk and interacted with students on Women Empowerment. In the evening, students performed various cultural programmes which were enjoyed by the local people.

Day 7: 10/02/2016 (Friday)

The seventh day was started with morning assembly and yoga exercises followed by Shramdan. In the first intellectual session, Dr. ShrikantBansod Divisional Coordinator, NSS guided students on Personality Development through NSS. In the interactive session, thoughts and ideas were exchanged on Leadership quality and Team Spirit and importance of collective responsibility in achieving common goals of community service was discussed. The session was attended by Prof. T.S.Wasnik, Dr.S.B.Kadu, Dr.Ramesh Kale. After intellectual session a meeting was organized by the Programme Officer to discuss the preparation regarding the valedictory function to be conducted on the next day.

Day 8: 11/02/2016 (Saturday)

The eighth day was the closing day of the camp. The volunteers continued this day by prayer and yoga exercises. They cleaned all the area of camp. The second session of the day was allotted to valedictory function. The function was presided over by Dr. F.C. Raghuwanshi Principal, Vidya Bharati Mahavidyalaya Dr. Rajesh Chouhan District Coordinator, NSS, SGBAU, Amravati, Dr.D.S.Ramteke Programme Officer, and Dr. N.R. ThoratAsstt. Programme Officer and Ms. Kishori Rajgure Lady Programme officer. The programme was started with lightening of the lamp and garlanding the portrait of Sant Gadge Baba by the hands of the chief guest Dr. F.C. Raghuwanshi. Several N.S.S. Volunteers share their experience about various activities undertaken during their 7 days period of stay in the village. Principal appreciated the Volunteers and staff for their work and thanked the village authorities for their support. On this occasion Dr.Rajesh Chauhan Chief Guest of the programme addressed to the gathering about role of youth in developing the country. The session was concluded by vote of thanks proposed by NSS Program officer Dr.D.S.Ramteke.

After lunch NSS Programme officer and volunteers organized a meeting with the villagers and departed from the Karala for our destination Vidyabharati Mahavidyalaya, Amravati with good blessings of the villagers.
